

Warren Mott Band Member Statement of Uniform Responsibility 2011

As a member of the Warren Mott Band Program I understand that I am required to be in full uniform for all performances. I understand that I will be issued a uniform coat, pants, cape, hat & plume for marching season. For concert season, I will receive a black skirt (women) or a black tuxedo jacket and slacks (men). It will be my responsibility to see that my uniforms are clean and in appropriate condition at all times. Should my uniform not be wearable at any event, I understand that I forfeit my right to participate in that event. I also understand that I will receive the appropriate grade for said event. I further understand that I am responsible for any damage or loss to the uniforms while they are in my possession. I (or my parents) will not make any alterations without first consulting the Uniform Chairperson.

Please refer to the Band Camp Handbook for the description and rules regarding your yearly issued Marching Band and Concert Band uniforms.

Signing this Uniform Responsibility agreement will cover your responsibility for care of all uniforms issued to you for each of the four years of your attending and/or membership in the Warren Mott High School Bands.

Having read the above, I hereby acknowledge my responsibility as a student in the Warren Mott Band. I understand that I will be required to keep my uniform in good condition and have it and all components ready for all performances. The uniforms are the property of the Warren Mott Band and will be returned in the same condition they were received in. I understand that I am responsible for the cost of both uniforms if either should be damaged or lost in any way.

Having read the above, I acknowledge the responsibility of my student and myself with regard to uniform wear and care. The uniforms are the property of the Warren Mott Band and will be returned in the same condition they were received in. I understand the \$50.00 uniform deposit, that was paid when my student entered the program, is held in reserve. If there is damage or loss to uniforms this will be applied and further charges may be assessed if necessary. When a student graduates or leaves the program the deposit will be refunded after it has been verified that uniforms have been returned and are in good condition. All graduating seniors will automatically receive their deposits the August after graduation. Any student leaving the program before graduation must submit a letter to the WMBC president within six months, stating that they have left the program and that they wish to have the deposit returned. I understand that my student and I are responsible for the cost of the uniforms if they should be damaged or lost in any way.
